





Thanks for your assistance in the Hollywood Prayer Tour we held on Sunday morning, August 21st, the morning after your Anaheim LivingVictory meeting ended! We had 10 reservations and 5 in attendance. See the group photo below.

As you may remember from the KCM video partner profile that you had Mika Simpson produce on our ministry in 2014, in 1996 we adapted the prayer tour concept to Hollywood, with an annual Hollywood Prayer Tour from your West Coast Believers Conventions through 2009, and then from your Copeland Family Meeting at Long Beach in 2010.

In 2011 we began holding annual Hollywood Prayer Tours in February each year to coincide with Ted Baehr's MovieGuide Awards Gala and the Academy Awards.

At the same time God gave us a relationship with a local church in Southern California, 1st Baptist Church and Messianic Fellowship of Buena Park, pastored by Wiley Drake. Pastor Drake has been conducting a Hollywood Prayer Tour for the last several years on the third Saturday morning of each month. When I join them in February each year this church has been providing me with free housing, free use of a rental van with driver and other believers in Jesus to help me pray over Hollywood.



Thanks again for your assistance in the Washington, D.C. Prayer Tour we held on Sunday, November 13, at 9 A.M. until 11 A.M., on the morning after your recent D.C. Victory Campaign ended! This was our 22nd annual Washington, D.C. Prayer Tour in conjunction with your D.C. meeting.

The reservations totaled 47, of which 40 people actually showed up on Nov. 13 (see group photo below). The Quality Tours bus we used was on-time, in excellent condition, with a friendly, capable driver. We ended the tour with a group prayer as we passed the Hylton Chapel for God to strengthen Kenneth and Gloria and all of you from KCM as a special multiplied return for giving us the glorious D.C. Victory Campaign again this year!


This year's prayer tour fell five days after Presidential Election Day (Nov. 8) so we prayed special on Nov. 13 for a smooth, efficient post-election transition in the White House and at every level across our nation. We reminded the group of Kenneth Hagin's vision of three frogs leapfrogging across the land in his book The Art of Prayer, which urges believers to use our authority in Jesus' name to bind demonic spirits causing economic turmoil, attacks on the President and riots.



This outdoor rally is held by the Jericho Prayer Movement every year at the Martin Luther King, Jr. (MLK) Monument in Washington, D.C. The design of the MLK monument is based on Dan. 2: a stone cut out of a mountain without hands by God from heaven becomes a great stone and fills the whole earth after it smashes and pulverizes every worldly oppressive anti-christ kingdom! Inside the split mountain (SEE ABOVE) of the MLK monument is written, "Out of the mountain of despair, a stone of hope" an obvious reference to the supernatural courage and wisdom MLK received from God to oppose the evils of racial injustice, as shown in the recent acclaimed movie "Selma." (TOP) JULY 2: For several years on the first Sat. morning of every month from 7 A.M. - 8 A.M. NPE Director Jeff Wright has been attending the JERICHO PRAYER MOVEMENT, a joint D.C. area churches outdoor prayer meeting (www.jerichoprayermovement.org). For the last 10 years simultaneous outdoor prayer meetings have been held from 7 A.M.-8 A.M. on the first Saturday of every month at 13 strategic D.C. locations including the U.S. Capitol, Supreme Court, State Dept., White House, Washington Monument, Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial and in Southeast and Northeast D.C. by churches of different ethnicities and denominations joining from opposite sides of the D.C. metro area--an encouraging display of unity in the D.C. Body of Christ!

Prayer Tour—David was raised in Zambia, has studied and ministered for decades across America, most recently in Tulsa, OK including Oral Roberts University and C. Peter Wagner's Leadership Institute, and has plans to relocate to D.C. in Jan. 2017 to pray for America and the world.

Minister Johnny Rice was a member of Rodney Howard-Browne's River Church in Tampa, FL before being led of God to minister in India, Africa and California. In the summer of 2015 he was led of God to move to D.C. to focus on evangelism, prayer and shofar-blowing with a loud speaker playing Benny Hinn worship near the White House, U.S. Capitol, Lincoln Memorial and Trump Hotel, in addition to the two major political party conventions last summer in Cleveland and Philadelphia, and since Nov. 8 in front of Trump Tower in NYC. And to say, "Jesus is Lord over China-let the dragon bow before the lamb, in Jesus' name!" Ps. 91 is the answer to ending Christian persecution worldwide as Christians worldwide remember to say Ps. 91 out loud over themselves every day!
