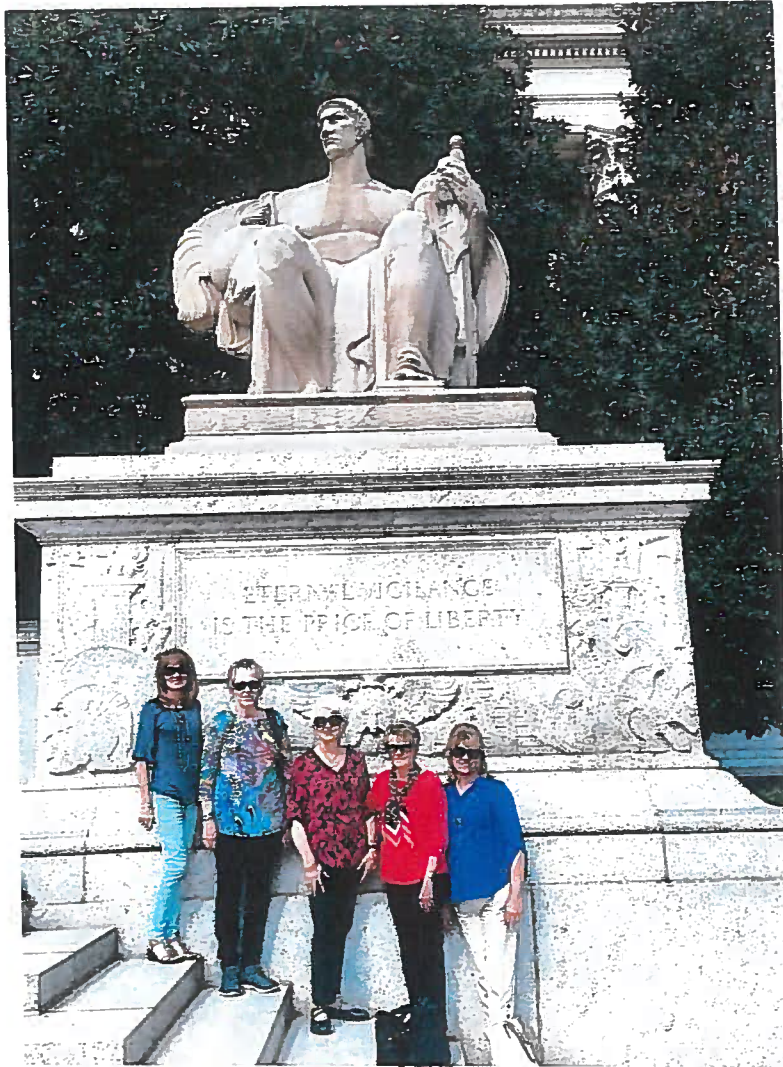

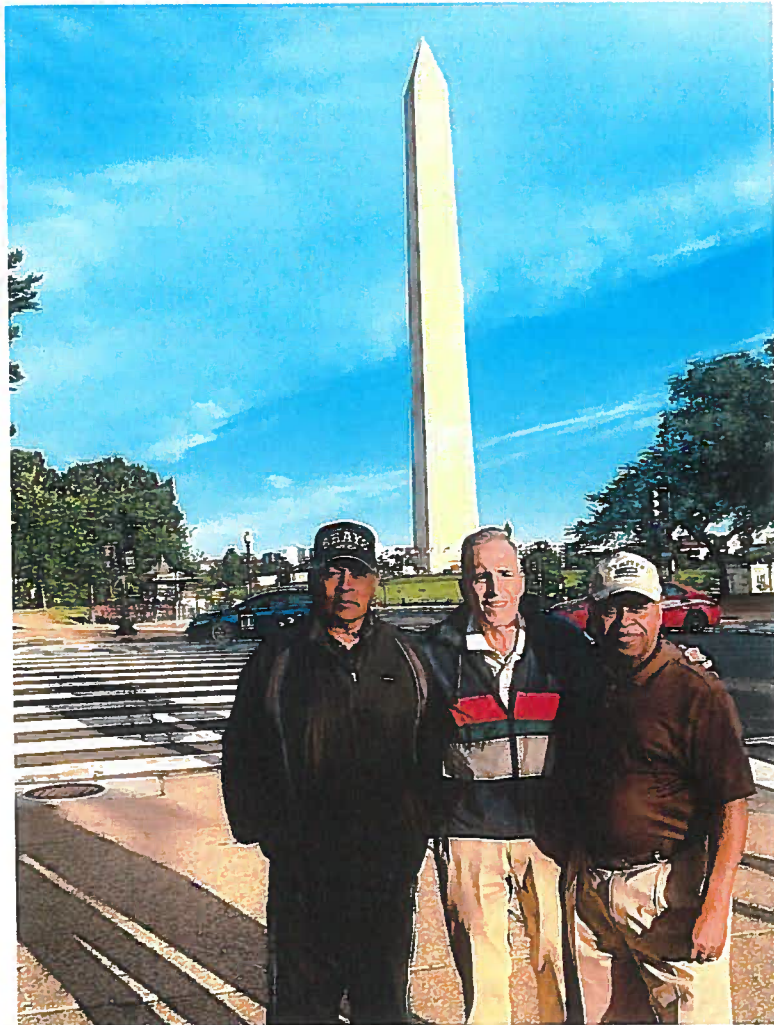

Brian Wills and his wife, Beth, are itinerant missionaries whose vision is to bring hope and healing to this generation. Through their ministry, Healing For The Nations, they have corporately traveled to over thirty-five nations of the world.

As ordained ministers, Brian and Beth travel and speak in Christian churches of all denominations and sizes. They primarily teach on faith, healing, revival, and knowing who you are in Christ.

Brian is a conference speaker and conducts healing services and workshops. His passion is to train others on "how to do the works of Jesus." 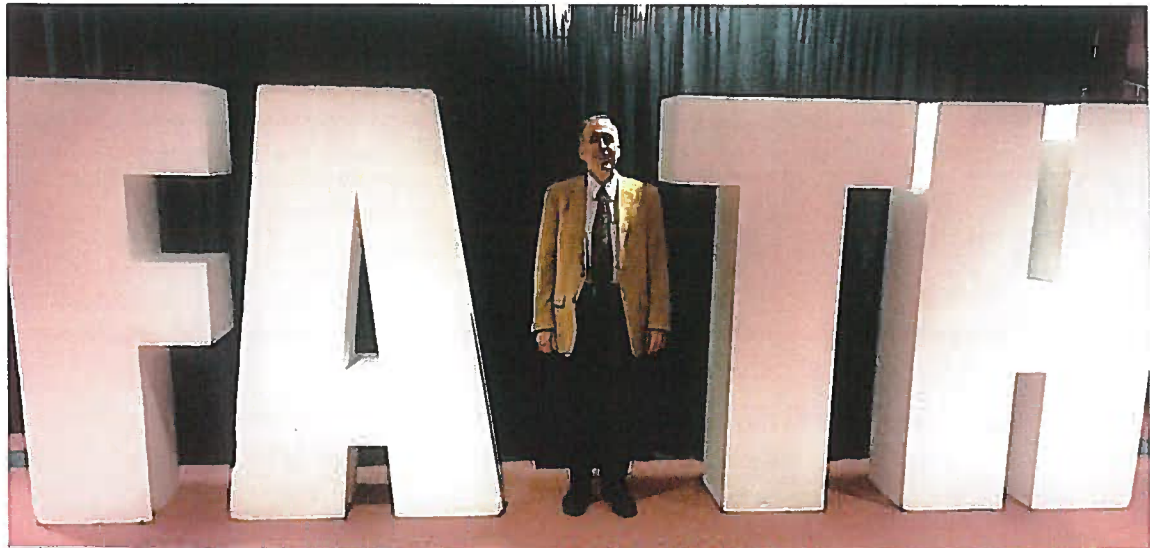

PSALM 91

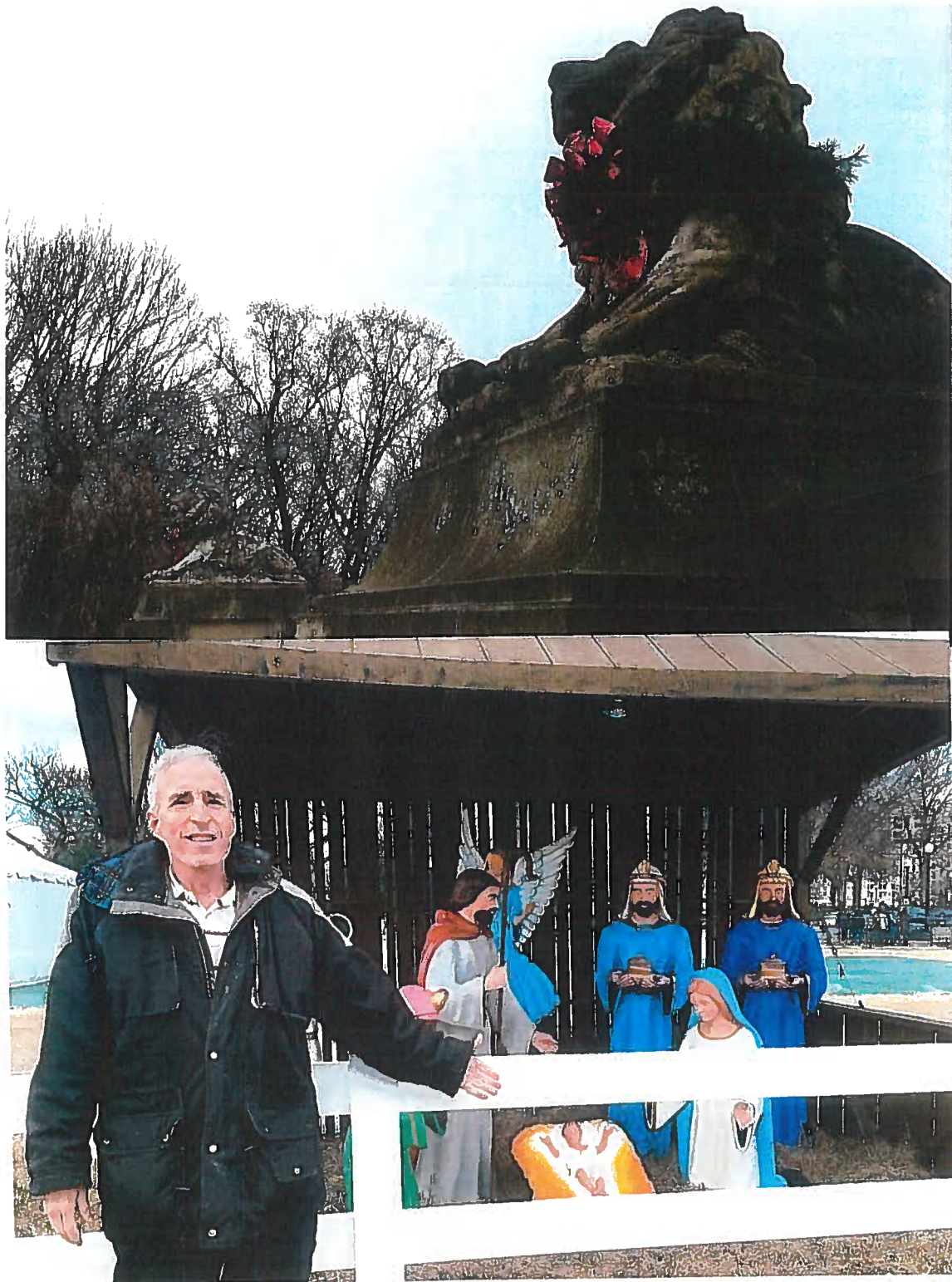
1. He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

Above pocket cards of Psalm 91 are available in bulk from Kenneth Copeland Ministries. We have been passing them out to the U.S. Capitol police (latest visit Sept. 26) to the White House Secret Service (latest visit Dec. 25 above) to the Justice Dept. guards (latest visit Dec. 24, 2017) and to the Secret Service at the Israeli Embassy (latest visit June 24). We tell the officers that Ps. 91 is the best prayer in the Bible for protection, that officers who say this out loud every day have a much lower rate of injury, which is what we want for them, because we're praying for their safety and we appreciate their service. The above "much lower rate of injury" claim is based on a testimony included in the book Hand On The Helm by Katherine P. Carter which tells of a British regiment in World War I all of whom were required to recite this Psalm out loud every day—in four years of frontline fighting they had no casualties! This book is still available from Amazon.com.



(TOP) At Christmastime the stone lions on the Connecticut AV bridge over Rock Creek in DC wear wreaths of red and green. When Jeff Wright came to DC in 1983 this bridge was known for suicide jumpers, which we began specifically praying against in Jesus' name each week as we crossed **(BOTTOM)** This life-size nativity scene has been displayed every year since 1954 between Thanksgiving and New Year's Day near the National Christmas Tree on the south side of the White House, except for 11 years from 1973-1983 when a separation of church and state lawsuit removed it. But now after a Supreme Court decision in 1984 it's been back every Christmas since—we're praying it shall never be removed again! The following page shows a street ministry tract Jeff Wright found near the White House on Christmas Day—Jesus is Lord over DC!

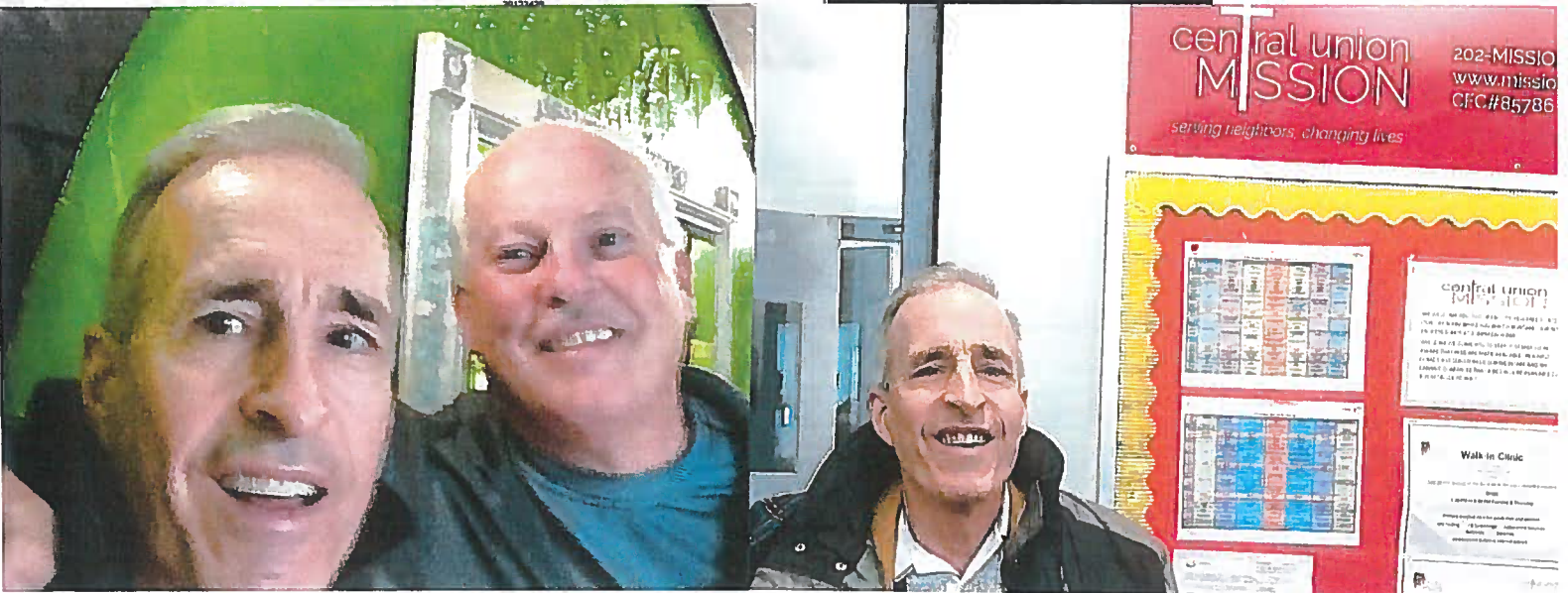
