"Declaration of Independence From the Devil"

When in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for any persons to dissolve the spiritual bands which have connected them with the evil power known as the devil, and to assume among the people of the earth, the special and righteous station to which the word of God and the blood of Jesus entitles them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, because God is no respecter of persons, and that all men are endowed by their Creator with certain inalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness, because God is good and God is love and God loves all people and wants all people to enjoy all His blessings!

To keep themselves from slipping back into sin and all of its snares, they can remind themselves as necessary of all that satan has done to torment them and their ancestors, so that they will lose all desire to ever consider falling back under the devil's tyranny. The history of the devil is a history of repeated injuries and usurpations, all having in direct object the establishment of an absolute tyranny over all mankind. To prove this, let facts be submitted to a candid world.

The devil was created to lead worship in heaven, but got the Big Head and decided he would ascend to the throne of God and be like the Most High. He created strife in heaven and convinced other angelic forces to join his rebellion. For all this he was cast out of heaven and his angels with him.

At that point the devil came down to the earth having great wrath, knowing that he only has a short time before he shall be --to next page--

Using Adam's lease he became the god of this world who blinds the minds of them which believe not the gospel, and with their unwitting cooperation he continues to use their authority to resist the purposes of God in the earth.

As soon as Adam and Eve were out of the garden, the devil got one of their sons, Cain, to kill his brother, Abel, and folks have been killing each other at the devil's urging ever since.

Now we know the truth and the truth has made us free, and we declare ourselves to be totally free and independent of all the devil's influence and we rebuke him and renounce him and cut off all ties that have ever existed between us and him. And in the name of our Savior Jesus Christ we command the devil to Go!--Come out!--and Stay Far Away!--from our lives, our families, our church, our nation and our world.

We declare ourselves off limits for the devil and all of his evil spirits, but we declare ourselves to be one spirit with the Lord who inhabits us as His Holy temple and who now sends us forth to take the light of His Word to all the nations, so that we shine forth now as fireworks lighting up the night sky, except that we fade not away, but our path is like the shining light of day that grows brighter and brighter, and lo our redemption draws —to next page—
