606 B.C. Babylonians destroy Jerusalem & take Jews to Babylon

(Is. 44:26-28; 45:1-25) allows Jews to return to rebuild the temple

(2 Chr. 36:22-23; Ezk. 1:1-4)

Cyrus replaced Medo-Persian

Darius who in 538 B.C. conquered

-79 Babylon (Da. 2:39; 5:31)

457 B.C. Artaxerxes allows Ezra to return to Jerusalem to teach the Word

(Ez. 7:6-10) in the 7th year of

-13 (20-7) Artaxerxes (Ez. 7:7)

444 B.C. Artaxerxes allows Nehemiah to return to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem

(Neh. 1:1-11; 2:1-9) in 20th year (1:1)

332 B.C. Greece conquers Jerusalem
(Da. 2:39)

165 B.C. Judas Maccabeus - Hanukkah

63 B.C. Rome conquers Jerusalem
(Da. 2:40)

Dan. 9:24-27 $7+(3 \times 20) + 2 = 69$ weeks

A year for a day: Ezk. 4:6 & Nu. 14:34

= 69 weeks x 7 = 483 days = 483 years

536 BC	483	483	Jerusalem destroyed
<u>-483</u>	<u>-457 BC</u>	<u>-444 BC</u>	by Romans
53 BC	26 AD	39 AD	70 AD

Jesus (born in 4 BC) starts public
ministry at age 30 (Lk. 3:23) in 26 AD
(Sept.) Mk. 1:15; Gal. 4:4: time fulfilled;
crucified in 30 AD (April) = 3 & 1/2 years
= Da. 9:27 the midst of the 70th week.
