

In the summer of 2015 he was led of God to move from California to D.C. to focus on politics, evangelism, prayer and shofar-blowing with a loud speaker playing Benny Hinn worship near the White House, U.S. Capitol, Lincoln Memorial and Trump Hotel, in addition to the two major political party conventions last summer in Cleveland and Philadelphia, and after Nov. 8th in front of Trump Tower in NYC. 

- 1. He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
- 2. I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.
- Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence.
- 4. He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler.
- 5. Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day;
- Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday.
- A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee.

- 8. Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked.
- Because thou hast made the Lord, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation:
- 10. There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.

Above pocket cards of Psalm 91 are available in bulk from Kenneth Copeland Ministries. We have been passing them out to the police at the U.S. Capitol (such as at our latest visit on May 31) and to the Secret Service agents at the White House (such as at our latest visit on April 14). We tell the officers that Ps. 91 is the best prayer in the Bible for protection, and that officers who say this out loud every day have a much lower rate of injury, which is what we want for them, and we're praying for their safety and we appreciate their service. This is a great way to witness to police, military or security personnel anywhere! The above "much lower rate of injury" claim is based on a testimony included in the book Hand On The Helm by Katherine P. Carter published by Whitaker House in 1977 which tells of a British regiment in World War One all of whom were required to recite this Psalm out loud every day—in four years of frontline fighting they had not one casualty! This book is still available from Amazon.com.
